Showtime is now just three weeks away and preparations and rehearsals are reaching their most crucial stages it is important that you all make sure you attend all of your class rehearsals and read your information letters thoroughly. Below is a reminder of the information given pre-Christmas holidays. Please familiarise yourself with your theatre call times and performance times: (Reminder that there are TWO performances on Saturday 28th Jan)

- * Friday 27th January: Evening performance begins at 7:00pm - Performers are to be at the Floral Pavilion Theatre for 4.30pm.
- * Saturday 28th January: Matinee performance begins at 1:00pm - Performers are to be at the Floral Pavilion for 11:00am
- * Saturday 28th January: Evening Performance begins at 7:30pm - Performers are to be at the theatre for 5:00pm. Each Performance is expected to run for 2hours 30minutes.

(Students under the age of 16yrs and performing in both the Saturday matinee and evening show, MUST be collected at 3:30pm following the matinee performance and returned to the theatre at 5:00pm, this is for licensing purposes. Any parent whom would find this difficult must speak with Tracey immediately.) over 16s are also asked to vacate the theatre between performances to enable staff to prepare the theatre and dressing rooms for the evening show. A costume list is presented in brief overleaf, Anamal takes care of the majority of costuming. Please use this list to familiarise yourself with your routine's costume and the items you require personally.

DROP OFF AND COLLECTION ARRANGEMENTS

Students must be dropped off at the theatre's side doors for registration (DO NOT DROP OFF AT THE MAIN FOYER). Students will here be signed in and handed over to their relevant Matrons and Chaperones. Parents are not permitted backstage at anytime. Collection following the performance will take place at the auditoriums main doors leading into the Foyer. The auditorium MUST be cleared before we allow children through, this is for their safety, children will be dismissed youngest first and we ask parents to fully co-operate on this matter and thank you in advance for your patience.

COSTUME LIST.

Please find below a list of routines and their costume description. (Girls) Hair is to be worn in a ponytail with a quiff at the front, this must be done neatly and prior to arrival at the theatre. Any costume which requires a different hair style will have information stated below. Items in red are **dancers own**, all other items are provided by Anamal and will be handed out at the theatre.

TRINITY:

Aladdin - Trinity Jnrs/inters. Arabian dancers/swordsman/character costumes provided , **bare feet.**

Footloose - Trinity Snrts - **Dancers own jeans, white t-shirt or vest(girls) chequered shirts,** boot covers provided.

Beauty and the Beast - Trinity Snrs - Costumes provided (individual items will be discussed in class)

BALLET/MODERN/CONTEMPORARY:

Ballet Chocolat - Tutus and accessories provided - **Dancers must wear own pink ballet tights and pink ribboned shoes.** Hair to be worn in a slick bun.

Primary Ballet - The Fairy Dance - Fairy Costumes and wings provided - **Dancers must wear own pink ballet tights and pink shoes.** Hair to be worn in slick Bun.

Modern - Hold my Hand - Black Modern Unitards. Hair to be worn in Pony Tail.

Contemporary - Black circular satin skirts and coloured Satin Belts. **Dancers require own Black leotards.**

STREET:

5-6s Street Students will receive their own named t-shirt to be worn with their own **PLAIN black tracksuit bottoms and black shoes.** (Children will be allowed to keep their t-shirts following their performance) Hair to be worn up in a slick ponytail with a quiff at the front.

'Party all night' - **Students will require own PLAIN black bottoms and Plain Black footwear,** Logo T-shirt provided at the theatre.

'Who's Laughing Now' - Dancers require **own black school tights and black pumps.** Girls Hair to be worn in Bunches above ear height. Anamal Provides rest of costume, inc, blk skirt, trousers, T-shirts, Blazer.

'Psyco' - Tracksuit Provided - Dancers will wear black face paint - (please advise if any allergies) **Dancers require own plain black dance shoes.**

'Moves like jagger' - Skinny jeans and rolling stones logo shirts and scarf. **Dancers require own plain black pumps/dance shoes.**

'Turn me on' - Black legging, Black Beyonce style leotard, high boot covers - all provided. **Dancers require own Plain Black footwear.**

'Take it off' - Grey Joggers and Coloured top, **Dancers can accessories their costumes with own colourful accessories such as caps, scarves, bandanas...**

BREAKING ROUTINES:

Beginners/intermediates - Shirts and T-shirt Provided. **Dancers require own PLAIN black bottoms and black footwear, dancers can accessories with appropriate colour match items.**

Advanced - As discussed in class groups.

LOCKING ROUTINES:

Beginners Locking/Popping Sat - t-shirts and shirts provided. **Dancers require own black bottoms and foot wear.**

Advanced - Trousers, shirts, waistcoats, braces and long socks.

SENIORS

16+ Adv (Anna) - white military jackets, white knee high boots, **Dancers own black leotard, Black Leggings, black footwear.**

LionKing - Singers and Dancers, Costumes provided though some of you may need own leggings/vests to be discussed in class. Bare Feet.

Nacers Hip-Hop and Locking pieces - Secretarial wear as discussed in class. Please check your costumes with Nacer's during class pre-show.
